



## CITY OF SAN ANTONIO CONVENTION & SPORTS FACILITIES

When it pertains to the restriction of weapons,  
the policy of the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center is as follows:

As a municipally-owned venue, the HBGCC is required to comply with State Law as it pertains to the open and concealed carrying of handguns. As a private licensee holding a private event within the HBGCC, it is the licensee who will make the determination as to whether Open Carry is allowed within their leased space during the time of their event. As such, it is up to each licensee to inform the HBGCC and their clientele of their policy. If the customer determines they want their leased areas to be restricted, they must work with their decorators or a sign company to create the applicable signage and place the signs accordingly. All signage must be structured according to Texas State Law. Sign must be bilingual with clearly visible lettering which must be 1 inch. Signage can only be placed at the entrances to client's licensed space.

Heavy poster board or form core are the best options due to size of sign needed.

A 30.06 sign is a sign that will restrict a LTC (*License to Carry*) holder from entering the business with a concealed handgun. The sign must contain the exact words required by Section 30.06 in both English and Spanish, be placed in the entrance to contracted space, and have 1" lettering or it will not be considered a legally-binding 30.06 sign.

A 30.07 sign is a sign that will restrict a LTC holder from entering the business with a handgun carried openly. The sign must contain the exact words required by Section 30.07 in both English and Spanish, be placed in the entrance of contracted space, and have 1" lettering or it will not be considered a legally-binding 30.07 sign.

***You will need both signs posted in order to restrict both versions of carried firearms.***
